

 Following a USTDA reverse trade mission that brought delegates from the Colombian oil and gas sector to the United States, Colombia expanded and modernized the Cartagena Refinery utilizing U.S. products and services from 11 suppliers from the greater **Tulsa, OK** area.

 A USTDA-funded feasibility study supported the Philippine Meteorological Agency's installation of modern weather forecasting systems with technologies from a U.S. supplier in **Norman, OK** that helped improve the dissemination of real-time weather data and natural disaster information.
