**26** Oregon companies gained new business from USTDA activities



### PROVEN RESULTS FOR OREGON BUSINESSES

⚡ Through a USTDA technical assistance project, a business in **Wilsonville, OR** was identified as a potential supplier of sulfur hexafluoride-detecting cameras. As a result, the company sold 12 cameras to Mexico's Federal Electricity Commission, enabling the country's power plants to comply with environmental regulations.

🚩 As a result of a USTDA-funded feasibility study, a **Beaverton**-based firm won a contract with Buenaventura Regional Port Authority in Colombia to provide server software to store closed-circuit television footage and improve port security.
