

A USTDA-funded training grant to Sonelgaz, Algeria's national electricity company, led to the procurement of U.S. power generation equipment, including gas and steam turbines manufactured at **General Electric's** plant in **Greenville, SC** to power eight million Algerian households.



Through a USTDA reverse trade mission, a **Columbia-**based engineering firm won highway construction and consulting services contracts in Vietnam, helping to increase capacity and reduce transit times.
