

✂ USTDA funded technical assistance that assessed energy storage technology options and their feasibility in South Africa, which allowed **UniEnergy Technologies (Mukilteo, WA)** to develop market opportunities for vanadium redox flow batteries in the country.

📦 USTDA funded a feasibility study to determine appropriate telecommunication, information technology, and software systems to improve logistics for ports and container terminals in Ho Chi Minh City. Following the study, a company based in **Seattle** exported port management software to northern Vietnam.
